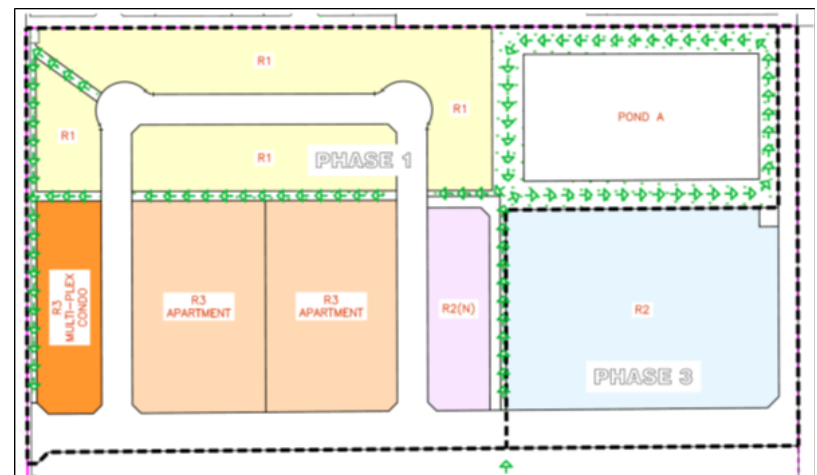

Bylaw 2018-18 to amend the Miller Meadows Area Structure Plan, Bylaw 2008-09, to accommodate the proposed changes to the area including 60 Street to the north boundary of the plan area. (see photo to the right).



Bylaw 2018-19 to redesignate that portion of the north of the Miller Meadows Area Structure Plan, which includes the future 60 Street and all areas north of that road. (see photo below).
