Follow these 4 steps:

1. Remove lids and caps from bottles and cans.
2. Empty and rinse containers. Labels can be left on.
3. Place recyclables loose in the recycling bin. Do not put them in bags.
4. Flatten cardboard boxes.

Do not include:

- Bagged recyclables
- Plastic bags or film
- Disposable coffee cups
- Household hazardous waste
- Scrap metals
- Electronics & batteries
- Plastics without 1-7  symbol
- Plasticized, waxed and laminated material
- Mirrors, ceramics, window glass or Pyrex®
- Styrofoam®
- Paper plates
- Light bulbs
- Wood waste
- Tissues/paper towels
